## Our initiatives include

- Using previous high yield support strategies for Numeracy and Writing programs. (Writing Cycle and targeted maths intervention groups).
- Providing teachers with access to structured intervention programs delivered by expert teachers.
- Using trained teacher aides to enable needs based grouping in classes to target specific skills in 8 week cycles.
- Teachers using data and regularly meeting to discuss data and student growth with members of the Administration team
- Focused data conversations with specific target children identified and tracked. Data conversations used to ensure classroom strategies are targeting student needs.
- · High level of resourcing to compliment the school programs in order to meet our student and staff needs.
- Intervention strategy based on Pat Maths data, Early Start data and grouping of like students.
